## Father Bader Scholarship.

These scholarships are available to children of Knights who are in good standing in their Council, or deceased Knights that were in good standing at the time of their death, are graduating from High School, and are pursuing their first year of higher education. The application forms are available beginning January 1, 2011. They may be downloaded from the internet at the Virginia State Council - Knights of Columbus, or requested from me via telephone or e-mail (see below). There are three forms to be filled out: the Application - completed by the applicant and a parent; the Membership Certification - completed by the financial secretary of the Father's council, and the student's principal completes the High School Certification form.

Winners of the scholarships are determined by the student's involvement in church, community and school, along with grade point average and financial need.

It is imperative that all three forms are completed and returned to me, to arrive not later than March 14<sup>th</sup>, 2011. Any application received after that date will not be considered. Also, incomplete applications will not be considered. All applications will be reviewed and judged to award the scholarships. The winners will be announced at the State Convention on April 30, 2011.

## Blood Drive Saturday, January 15, 2011

The Knights winter Blood Drive is scheduled for Saturday, January 15, 2011. In keeping with the spirit of Christmas, donating blood at our winter drive is giving a wonderful gift of life to those in life-threatening circumstances. Please bring another donor with you who would like to give this gift as well: a family member, friend or neighbor. Anyone from the age of 16 with an Inova Blood Donor Services (IBDS) form signed by a parent. There is no upper age limit for donors.

The blood donor station will be in the Holy Spirit School gymnasium between 6:45 am and 11:45 am. Inova Blood Donor Services has scheduled us for 168 slots, 11 more than at our last drive. IBDS has also set a goal for this drive of 134 units of red blood, 14 more than our most recent drive. In order to fill these slots, about 20 of which went unfilled in our last drive, I encourage each brother Knight to donate and try to recruit another who is willing to give an hour to save a life (or maybe two or three). Make this a family or neighborhood affair to help provide for what is typically less than a days blood reserve.

An IBDS form is available that can be sent via email by contacting one of us. The form will also be available on the day of the drive. In all cases donors must show a picture ID.

The appointment times are spread evenly through the morning, with 32 slots/hour for the 5 ¼ hour drive. It is expected that ten of the slots will be for the two ALYX stations that draw two units of red blood cells in an apheresis process. ALYX donations are scheduled every hour on the 45 minute tick. The first of these is at 6:45 and the last at 10:45.
